Lu Lin, professor and director of Biomass Chemical Engineering Research Institute in College of Light Industry and Food Engineering, South China University of Technology, is a member of Biomass Energy Association of China, a standing member of Technological Association of Pulp and Paper Association of Guangdong Province in China and member of Committee of Biomass Energy of China. From 2007, he serves academic periodicals of BioResources as one of co-editors and Journal of Bio-Based Materials and Bioenergy as one of editors.
