Limited types of financial aid may be available in the summer at SUNY-ESF for students who meet the following conditions:

Federal Loans

- Will be enrolled in a total of at least 6 credits of classroom-based courses during the entire summer term.
- Have remaining eligibility within their 2016-2017 annual loan limits.

Federal Pell Grants

- Will be enrolled in a total of at least 3 credits of classroom-based courses during the entire summer term.
- Were not enrolled full-time and receiving Pell at any institution in both the Fall 2016 and Spring 2017 semesters.

- Summer financial aid can only be offered for courses that are required for the student's primary degree program.
- Summer financial aid applicants agree to notify the Office of Financial Aid of any scheduling changes immediately.
- Summer financial aid applicants certify that the information reported on the application is true and accurate.
- Summer financial aid applicants understand that online courses are not eligible for financial aid and cannot apply to minimum enrollment requirements.
- Summer financial aid applicants must be meeting all Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements to be eligible.
