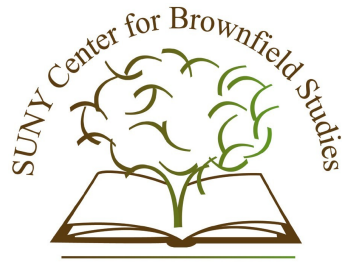




Teleconference

Brownfield Teleconference

ESF Outreach will host a **Brownfield Teleconference** on Monday, November 24, 2003 and Tuesday, December 2, 2003. Join us for this moderated telecast in Nifkin (Alumni) Lounge.



The teleconference will provide a forum with four modules for an official discussion of new legislation that created the Brownfield Cleanup Program (BCP). The goal of the BCP is to enhance private-sector cleanup of brownfields and to reduce developmental pressure on "greenfields".
