When trees are harvested from a forest there is always a potential to disturb forest soils, resulting in sediment-laden runoff which adversely impacts our streams, rivers, lakes, ponds and wetlands. Before and during times of harvest, use of Best Management Practices (BMPs) helps to minimize contamination of drinking water, as well as degradation of our fish and wildlife habitat.

The objective of the workshop is to enhance awareness surrounding best management practices(BMPs) and offer the participants a first-hand opportunity to see BMPs in action.
