**Course Description:** This course is designed so building contractors will understand the energy code and its application in the design of their structures.

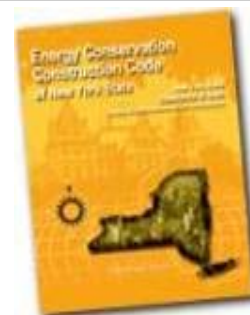
