

**SPPF SCHOLARSHIPS
FOR FRESHMEN AND TRANSFERS
Updated 3/26/10**

The Syracuse Pulp and Paper Foundation, Inc. (SPPF) awards scholarships to undergraduate students enrolled in Paper Science and Paper Engineering at SUNY College of Environmental Science and Forestry. SPPF scholarships are based on academic merit, and awards vary based on cumulative grade point average. Scholarships are renewed each semester subject to the approval of the SPPF Board of Directors.

The following eligibility requirements and restrictions apply to students that enter the Paper programs in Spring 2011, Fall 2010, Spring 2010, Fall 2009, Spring 2009 and Fall 2008.

1. Students must be enrolled in the Paper Science or Paper Engineering program at SUNY College of Environmental Science and Forestry and demonstrate satisfactory progress toward a BS degree in Paper Science or Paper Engineering as defined by the Faculty of Paper and Bioprocess Engineering in consultation with the SPPF Scholarship Committee and Board of Directors.
2. Scholarships are available to US citizens and permanent residents. Others may be considered at the discretion of the Foundation depending on availability of funds. The SUNY ESF Director of Business Affairs determines residency.
3. Freshmen who reside in New York State, and enter into Paper Science or Paper Engineering will receive \$3,000 per semester in the first year. Out-of-state freshmen who enter into Paper Science or Paper Engineering will receive \$3750 per semester in the first year. After the first year, scholarships are awarded on a semester basis per the Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) requirements identified below.
4. Scholarships for transfer students that enter Paper Science or Paper Engineering in Spring 2011, Fall 2010, Spring 2010, Fall 2009, Spring 2009 and Fall 2008 will be awarded per the Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) requirements identified below, and will be based on the final cumulative GPA from the transfer college. After the first year, scholarships are awarded on a semester by semester basis per the students ESF Grade Point Average (GPA) requirements identified below:

Cumulative GPA Requirements for SPPF Awards

GPA	NYS Residents	Out-of-state students
3.250 – 4.000	\$3000	\$3750
3.000 – 3.249	\$2200	\$2950
2.500 – 2.999	\$1620	\$2370

5. For students enrolled less than full time, the above rules apply on a prorated basis.

***Please note** that the scholarship program may be changed per the recommendation of the Foundation's Scholarship Committee and the approval of the SPPF Board of Directors. Awards may vary from semester to semester according to available resources.*
