

**SPPF SCHOLARSHIPS
FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS
IN PAPER SCIENCE OR PAPER ENGINEERING
AT
THE SUNY COLLEGE OF ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE AND FORESTRY.**

The Syracuse Pulp and Paper Foundation, Inc. (SPPF) awards scholarships to undergraduate students enrolled in Paper Science or Paper Engineering at the SUNY College of Environmental Science and Forestry. SPPF scholarships are based on academic merit, and awards vary based on class level and cumulative grade point average. Scholarships are renewed each semester, subject to the approval of the SPPF Board of Directors.

The following eligibility requirements and restrictions apply to students that enter the Paper programs in Spring 2012, Fall 2012 or Spring 2013:

1. Students must be enrolled in Paper Science or Paper Engineering at SUNY College of Environmental Science and Forestry and demonstrate satisfactory progress toward a BS degree in Paper Science or Paper Engineering as defined by the Faculty of Paper and Bioprocess Engineering in consultation with the SPPF Scholarship Committee and Board of Directors.
2. Scholarships are available to US citizens and permanent residents. Others may be considered at the discretion of the Foundation, depending on availability of funds. The SUNY ESF Director of Business Affairs determines residency.

Award Schedule for Spring 2012, Fall 2012 and Spring 2013:

1. Year one: Freshmen and transfer freshmen in Paper Science or Paper Engineering will receive \$500 per semester in the first year.
2. Year two: Those students enrolled in Paper Science or Paper Engineering that carry a GPA of 2.0 or above, will receive \$3,200 per semester, for two semesters.
3. Initial awards for transfer students, other than transfer freshmen, will be based on the final cumulative GPA from the transfer college.
4. Years 3+: Scholarships are awarded on a semester by semester basis, per the student's Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) as identified below.

Cumulative GPA Requirements for SPPF Awards (Year 3+)

GPA	NYS Residents	Out-of-state students (add \$750)
3.250 – 4.000	\$3200	\$3950
3.000 – 3.249	\$2350	\$3100
2.500 – 2.999	\$1730	\$2480

4. For students enrolled less than full time, the above rules apply on a prorated basis.

***Please note** that the scholarship program may be changed per the recommendation of the Foundation's Scholarship Committee and the approval of the SPPF Board of Directors. Awards may vary from semester to semester according to available resources.*
