

INTRODUCTION

The Career Services Office is pleased to present the results of the Class of 2012 Graduating Student Survey. The following data are representative of the post-graduation activities of degree recipients from December 2011, May 2012, and August 2012. This report is based on the responses from 428 out of 517 ESF degree recipients, representing an overall response rate of **82.8 percent.**

More specifically, the responses by degree level are as follows:

Associate degree level:

• 40 degree recipients with 37 respondents, representing a 92.5 percent response rate.

Undergraduate degree level:

• 361 degree recipients with 297 respondents, representing an 82.3 percent response rate.

Graduate degree level:

• 116 total degree recipients with 94 respondents, representing an 81 percent response rate.

The 2012 Graduating Student Survey was administered in the following ways:

December 2011 Graduates

- The survey was highlighted in the Career Services newsletter.
- A handout was given during a presentation made to all attendees at the annual convocation rehearsal.

May 2012 Graduates

- Information was included with convocation materials.
- A table was staffed during cap and gown pick-up to have graduates complete the survey.
- A handout was given during a presentation made to all attendees at the annual convocation rehearsal.

August 2012 Graduates

• The survey link was e-mailed to all August graduates.

The above identified strategies proved valuable in obtaining accurate contact information. In addition, the following steps were taken to gather information from non-responders, those who indicated they were not employed, and those who were not continuing their education:

- Multiple e-mails were sent throughout the year.
- Phone calls were made.
- Reached out to faculty and staff to assist with post-graduation activity with those they stay in contact with.

On behalf of the College, a special thank you is extended to the Class of 2012 for their assistance and contributions to this report.

Below are summary highlights from the data collected. Please note that these statistics are representative of the 428 respondents. To add greater transparency to the summary highlights and the post-graduation activity of the graduates, individual components of these data are categorized for your reference.

• The overall number of associate, undergraduate, and graduate degree recipients who are employed full-time, part-time, or attending graduate school is 78.3 percent.

- For the Class of 2012 (428 respondents), 19.6 percent reported they are continuing their studies full-time.
- For the Class of 2012 (428 respondents), 48.4 percent of associate, undergraduate, and graduate degree recipients reported being employed full-time, while 10.3 percent reported being employed part-time.
- 87 percent of those employed full-time indicated their position was related to their ESF major. For those employed part-time, 75.6 percent indicated their position was related to their ESF major.
- The average salary for SUNY-ESF undergraduates in 2012 was \$42,861.
- 90.1 percent of employed undergraduates reported they found their position within six months following graduation.
- 76.5 percent of undergraduate respondents indicated they participated in a student club or organization during their time at ESF.
- 66.7 percent of graduate students indicated they participated in research projects with faculty while at ESF.
- The most effective method by which 2012 graduates found employment was through networking. 50.3 percent of all graduate respondents reported they obtained their position through personal contacts and networking or by applying directly to the organization.

- 60.7 percent of undergraduates and 45.9 percent of graduates who identified full-time or part-time employment within their field of major found employment in New York State.
- Within New York State 39 percent of undergraduates along with 71 percent of graduates found employment in Central New York. Employment Geographic Summary can be found on page 50.
