Abstract Topic: NYS Affordable Housing Sustainability: Pathway to Decarbonization

Abstract:

New York State recently released a full Scoping Plan, approved by the Climate Action Council in December 2022, as directed by the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act of 2019. This scoping plan details out the State's carbon emissions by sector, noting that more than 30% of the emissions are from buildings, and includes a robust and comprehensive set of recommendations to achieve its goals, of which include a 40% carbon emissions reduction by 2030. NYS Homes and Community Renewal, the State's affordable housing agency, is aligning it's policies and standards with the Scoping Plan recommendations, aiming to set the tone for how housing decarbonizes in alignment with deep decarbonization goals and ensuring healthy and safe housing is preserved and constructed. HCR is launching new clean energy programs to make funding available and align the financing with the new standards, along with help from other State agencies such as NYSERDA. These strategies of creating industry guidelines and providing additional funding for properties able to achieve deeper decarbonization will help contribute to the State's goals of 2 million Climate Friendly Homes by 2030.
