Hi Mariko,

Chris and Adam were talking about approvals for our activities at Bartlett, and I realized that I don't have any record of approvals of our NEPA exclusion or our requests for permission to continue working in the Shoestring (Ca-C9) or the Chronosequence (H1-H6) sites. Chris has copies of our requests (attached), and there is room for signatures and dates at the bottom.

I'm sorry we haven't been sending you requests every year. I'm not sure how far behind we areif you have records of more recent requests than the ones attached here, I'll file all of them! Shall we send you one now that lists all activities since the last one (which might be 2011), or wait until your next review in the fall?

We are pretty much proceeding as planned, but the details are constantly changing. For example, the last version refers to isopods, which was Lisa Lavalley's RET project. After that, Rick Biché (RET) worked on soil arthropods, and now we have students working on snails.

There has been a lot of activity since 2011 measuring sap flow, do you have requests for permission from Heidi Abjornsen or Michele Pruyn to be working in our sites doing that? We are continuing those measurements this year. Michele was working in our Ca addition plots; do you have a request on file from Mark Green for those?

We'll start now preparing an update for you and send it along well in advance of your October review season.
