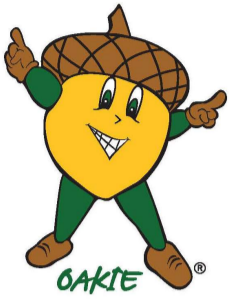

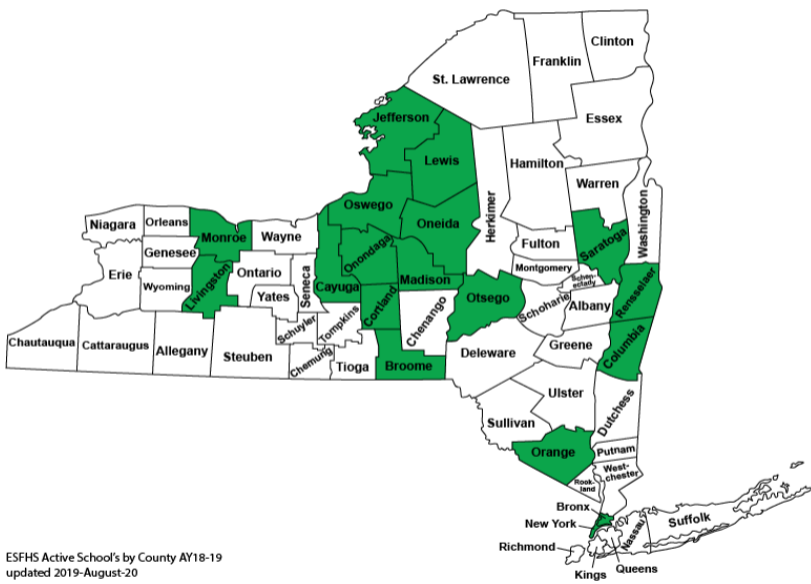

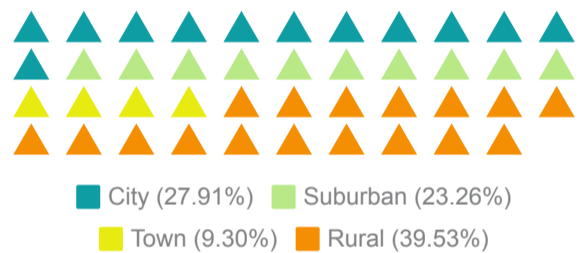


## Our Schools

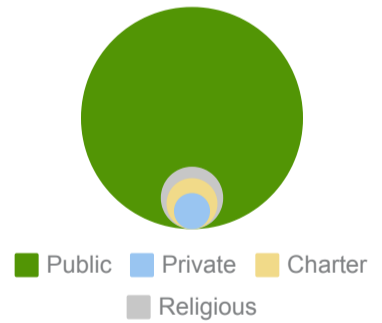
#### Where our schools are located in New York State
