

Recommended Small Shade Trees. (<25')

Viburnum lentago... "Pink Beauty" produces pink fruits to violet and is reported to be quite attractive. Viburnum lentago is a small tree, growing 15'-30'. Growth rate habit is medium with an arching habit. Foliage is soft green in the spring and becomes a glossy dark, and finally progresses to purple-red fall color.



Cornus alternifolia... The alternate-leaf Dogwood or a Pagoda Dogwood, tolerate to sun and shade sun exposure. It can handle a wide variety of soil types. The tree can reach up to 30' but the growth rate is slow to moderate. *Provides use for 43 different bird species.



Amelanchier arborea... Cultivars include 'Refzam' or reflection TM - an oval, upright trees reaching the height of 25'. Very ornamental tree, the fall foliage is dark yellow and orange.



Carpinus caroliniana... The American Hornbeam has cultivars that offer similar traits. The Iron wood is a very dense wood yet has smooth and ripple like muscles.



Betula populifolia... the Grey Birch tree has cultivars that are unique. the 'Lanciniata, the pinnately lobed leaves, 'Pendula'-with drooping branches and 'purpurea'-with purple leaves. These tree selections are really good examples of good smaller trees.



These trees are low in maintenance and are tolerable to both drought and saturated planting situations.

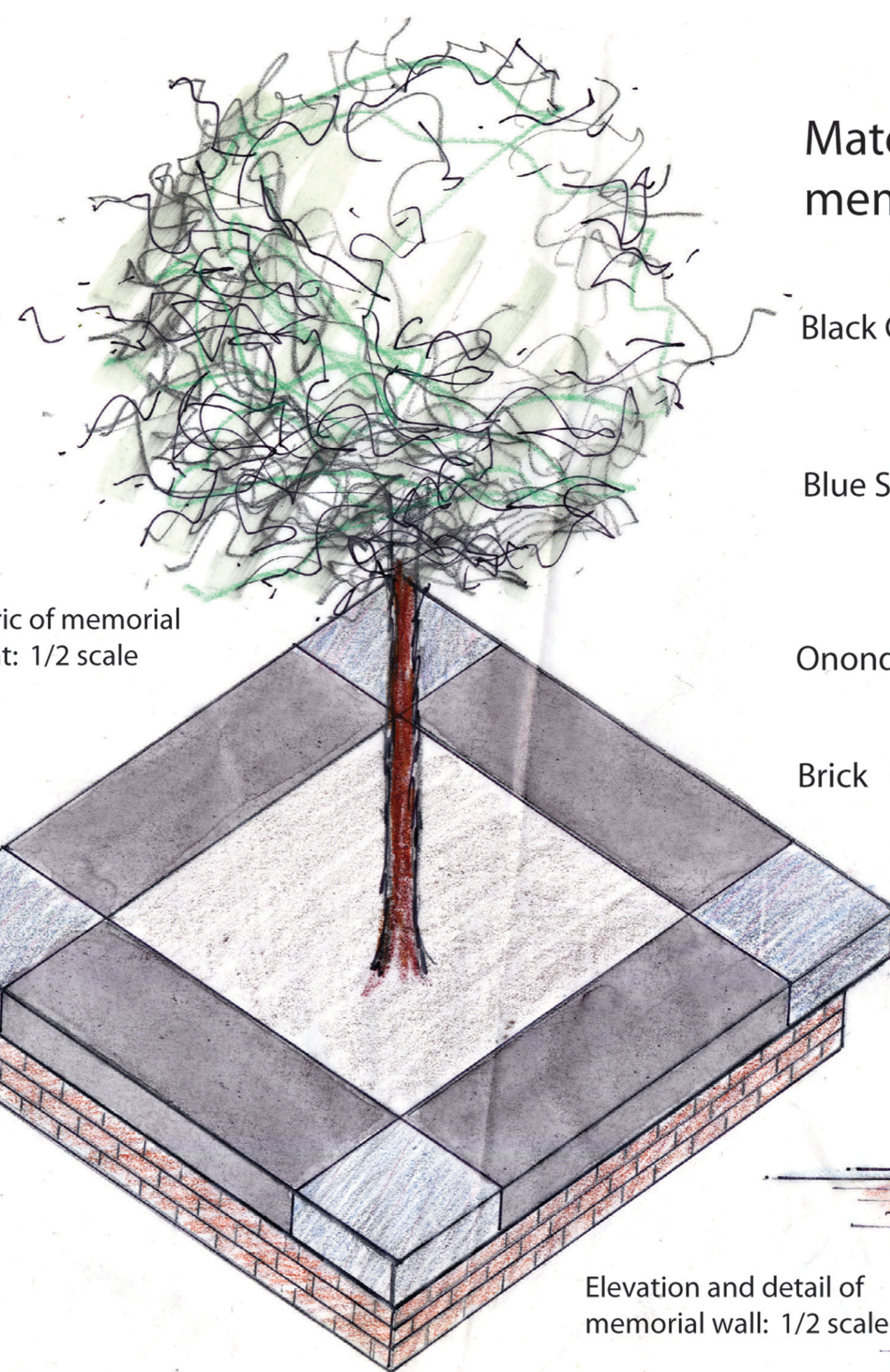
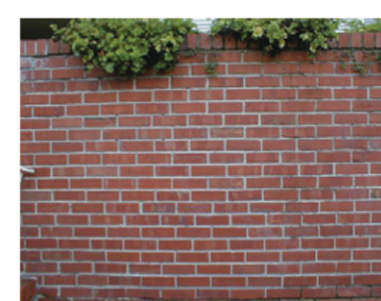

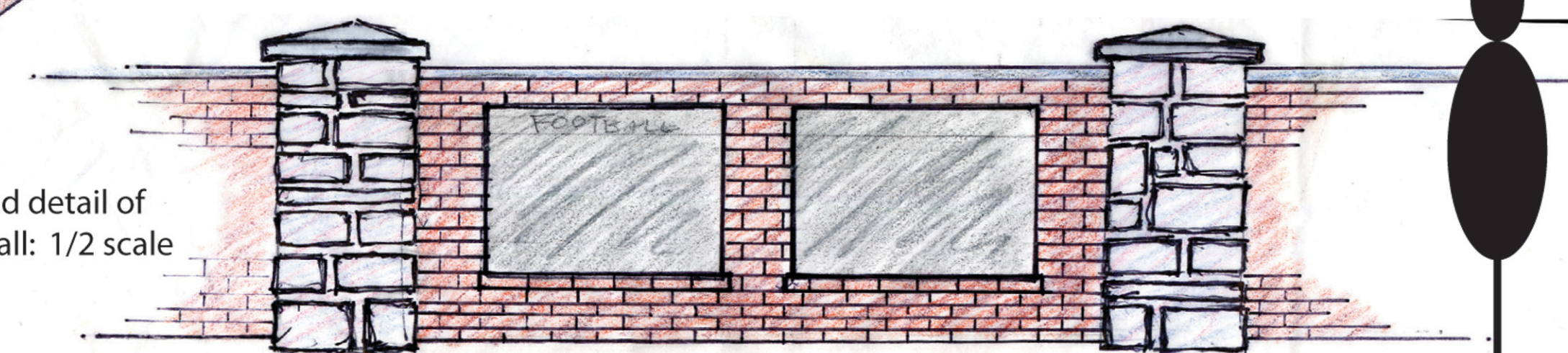
