Dear Ranger School Alumni,

The Wanakena Historical Association (WHA) Board of Trustees gratefully thanks the Ranger School alumni for their support through the long process of rebuilding the historic Wanakena footbridge. I bring with great pride and extreme joy, news that the WHA will not have to raise any additional funds

to reimburse the Town of Fine for the monumental task of rebuilding the Footbridge.

The Town of Fine & the WHA have been patiently waiting for the last grant money from New York State and had been forewarned of the possibility that the state could reject reimbursing significant costs as not acceptable per terms of the grant.

Below is a summary of the reconciliation of the final costs and outstanding balance owed to the Town of Fine.

- The total cost of rebuilding the footbridge stands at \$448,093.43
- The Town of Fine loaned us funds to cover ongoing costs: \$263,093.43.
- Funds raised by the WHA reimbursed the Town of Fine a total of \$185,673.99
- The outstanding grant money awarded was a whopping \$74,896.17
- After receipt of the Waterfront Revitalization Award, the WHA still owed the Town of Fine \$2,523.27
- This remaining amount has been generously pledged to be paid in full by Bernie & Valerie Carr!!!

Wanakena & the Fine Township are extremely appreciative of this last gift that ends over 4 years of planning and fund raising. We cannot forget the many donors and volunteers that made this happen. The grassroots effort that rebuilt the footbridge could not have occurred without the hundreds of donations, large & small.

The footbridge, as well as the Otto J Hamele historic walking tour has seen a significant uptick in visitors since the dedication of the new bridge July 4th, 2017 and will continue to make memories for RS students, families and tourists as they stroll on that so special swinging bridge for many years to come.


REUNION 2018:
