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Reviewer Comments for Author

This paper compares soil organic matter in a series of sites in the Adirondacks that were first described in 1933, relocated and sampled in 1984, and finally resampled with certainty in 2005-06. The study is unique in the length of the sampling interval, and is therefore worth publishing. More attention should be given to the problems of comparing the studies. How much uncertainty is introduced by the differences in methods, and what lessons should we take home for setting up long-term studies?

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
