Their work infuses the places where people live, work, and play with authentic narratives of the land that deepen their enjoyment of the natural world and inspire environmental stewardship.

NBW has expanded the traditional design process to include the voices of diverse partners, including farmers, ecologists, community members, and systems experts, to create new models of resilience and biodiversity.

Under Woltz's leadership, the firm has designed tens of thousands of acres of farms, parks, and preserves throughout North America, New Zealand, and Australia that includes reconstructed wetlands and meadows, reforested land, and flourishing wildlife habitat.

Woltz was educated at the University of Virginia and holds master's degrees in landscape architecture and architecture.
