Submit applications in person, by mail, fax or with the secure document exchange function available through the financial aid section of the MyESF portal.

Limited types of financial aid **may** be available in the summer at SUNY-ESF for students who meet the following conditions:

Federal Loans

- Will be enrolled in a total of at least 6 credits of degree-applicable courses during the entire summer term.
- Have remaining eligibility within their 2025-2026 annual loan limits.

Federal Pell Grants

- Will be enrolled in a total of at least 1 credit of degree-applicable courses during the entire summer term.
- Will be enrolled in a total of at least 6 credits of degree-applicable courses during the entire summer term if receiving funds in excess of 100% of a scheduled award.

Step 4: Terms and Conditions – All applicants must read the terms and conditions, then provide a certification signature. Applications will not be processed without a valid signature.

Summer 2026 Financial Aid Terms and Conditions

- Summer financial aid will only be disbursed for students who meet all general and specific program eligibility requirements.
- Summer financial aid funds may be cancelled and need to be returned if the student does not complete all scheduled classes.
- Summer financial aid can only be offered for courses that are required for the student’s primary degree program.
- Federal loans offered for the summer will only be processed if written acceptance is submitted to the Financial Aid Office.
- Summer financial aid applicants agree to notify the Office of Financial Aid of any scheduling changes immediately.
- Summer financial aid applicants understand that Pell Grant funds must be offered to the student if eligible. If a student does not want to receive Pell Grant funds a written request to that effect must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office.
- Summer financial aid applicants certify that the information reported on the application is true and accurate.
- Summer financial aid applicants must be meeting all Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements to be eligible.
