On Wednesday, November 9, 2016 at or about 1745 hours the SPD & DPS responded to 727 South Crouse Avenue (Komachi Restaurant and store) in response to an attempted robbery complaint. A student who was the victim reported that while visiting a friend at their place of business they were approached in an attempted robbery. The suspect entered the location and produced a note that read "I am now doing a robbery, give me your money". The suspect displayed a folding pocket knife. The suspect was not given any money and fled the scene in a northerly direction towards CVS drugstore. There were no injuries reported.

The DPS asks for your help in identifying a suspect if you were in the vicinity at the time of the incident. For this purpose, the following is the description of the suspect: The suspect is described being a male-white approximately 5'6-6' in height wearing a black windbreaker and black hoodie, with a black pants no further description
