Suspicious Event

DPS has received information that several women on campus have been approached a male subject and asked a number of unusual questions. The individual has stated that he is conducting a survey and that his survey requires that he ask the questions in a number of different settings. The male is described as being approximately 5'8" tall, thin build, with dark hair and dark eyes
