**ESF Campus Community:**

As some of you may be aware, there is a strong cold front crossing our area this evening sometime between 7 and 11pm. The front will bring with it showers and potentially severe thunderstorms. The thunderstorms may be accompanied by damaging wind gusts and heavy rain.

University Police is advising our community members to be aware of these potentially hazardous conditions and to take necessary precautions in order to work around this storm.

If you observe property damage or conditions on campus that cause risks to safety, contact University Police when you are able to do so safely @ (315) 470-6667. During this storm, we are advising you to stay clear of trees and other unsecured structures around campus. There will be a large tent on campus as well for the football game on Saturday. DO NOT use the tent as shelter from the storm.

If you need shelter from the storm, you may enter the east entrance of Bray Hall (under the Bray-Walters Bridge). This entrance is open 24/7 and is located right next to University Police.
